Though the end-result can often appear as if the beams are tightly woven into the fabric of the structure, all of our beams are non-structural, and can be installed using simple sleepers attached to studs. 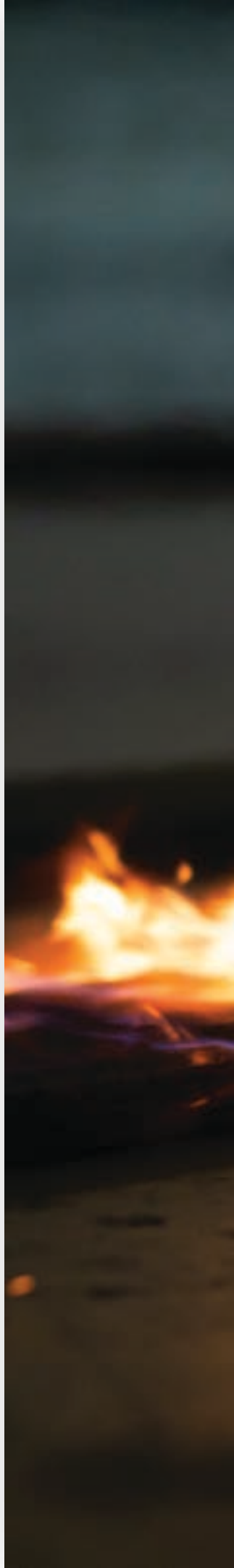
Reinventing a traditional Japanese art to give wood strength, character, and perseverance.

Shou Sugi Ban (also known as Yakisugi) is the Japanese art of charring wood to create a blackened, dark finish with unique properties and characteristics. When traditionally applied, the Yakisugi/Shou Sugi Ban process creates a layer of carbonization on the wood which offers a degree of natural resistance against water, fire, rot, and insects. This blackened surface ages with the elements, creating a stunning patina.

When applied for aesthetic purposes, the charring process creates unique shapes, textures, and tones that cannot be replicated through paint or stain. Products featuring an

aesthetic application still gain the natural benefits of this carbonized layer, but can be supplemented with additional finishing and sealers to create a product that is less delicate to the touch.

We offer a number of Shou Sugi Ban wood treatments, with varying levels of char and color characteristics. We also offer sealed Shou Sugi Ban, creating a more durable product for transport and protection against the elements on exterior surfaces. For extremely sensitive environments where exposed carbonization would be problematic, we offer Dāku Ban, an aesthetically-similar finish with no burn whatsoever.



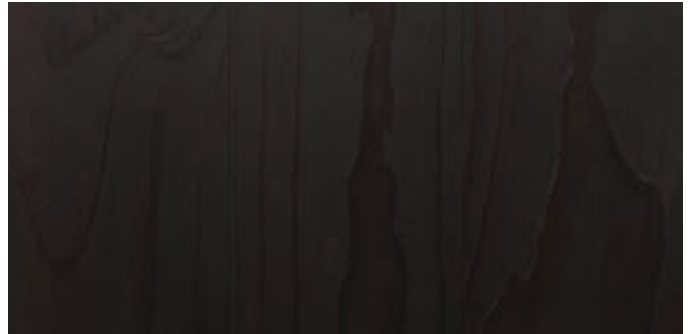

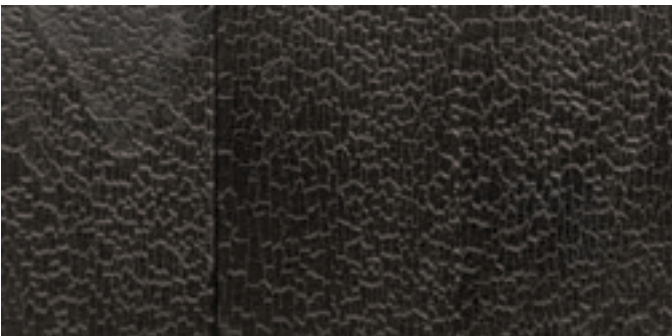

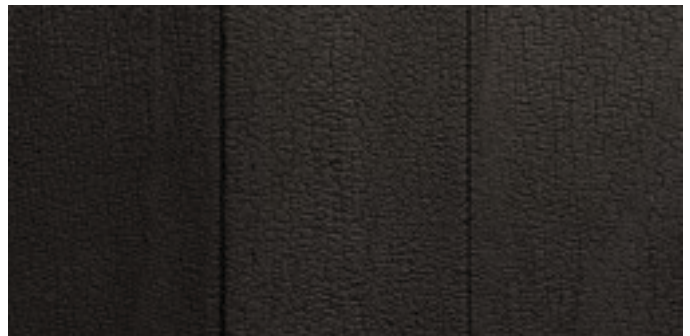

Our preferred woods for applying a Yakisugi/Shou Sugi Ban technique are Accoya® and Kebony. This is due to the incredible durability of these woods, both on the surface and throughout the core of the board, allowing for a carbonization that is overall more stable and durable than on other species.

Our Western Red Cedar and Northwestern Spruce Shou Sugi Ban/Yakisugi catalog offerings feature a lighter burn, and a charring pattern that retains

the natural texture of the wood. This creates a deep protective finish, without any additional coloring.

Alternately, our Dāku Ban options are specially designed to mimic the rich black finish of Shou Sugi Ban/Yakisugi without any charring whatsoever, for sensitive environments and installations. As always, custom colors, textures, and finishes are available upon request.

Hewn has partnered with Nova USA Wood to pair their industry-leading Rainscreen Siding ecosystem with our Hewn product offerings. Nova's QuickClip Rainscreen Siding System is engineered by nature to withstand the test of time and the elements. Professional builders favor their products for their high quality, high performance and consistency.

Real wood siding is subject to expansion and contraction in the width of the boards as a result of seasonal changes in humidity in any given individual location. Nova designed their Rainscreen QuickClip specifically to allow for this natural swelling and shrinkage in the widths of individual boards after installation. Nova's clips are stiff

enough to hold the gap perfectly during installation and yet are flexible and resilient enough to allow the wood swell up to 1/8" in width.

Rainscreen applications are a beautiful way to clad an exterior wall, making it less likely to suffer moisture problems that lead to rot and warping. And Nova's unique clip design allows for a rainscreen system adapted to the wood's natural needs.

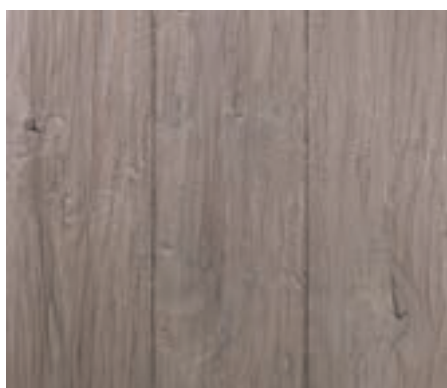
