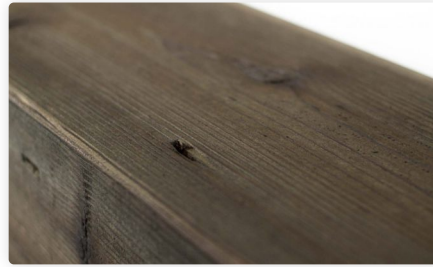

Brushed

Wire-brushed texture with a consistent thickness and a flat surface.



Distressed

Similar face to our Brushed texture, but with the addition of nail holes and cracks.



Hand Hewn

Crafted to mimic the shaping of wood with traditional hand tools.

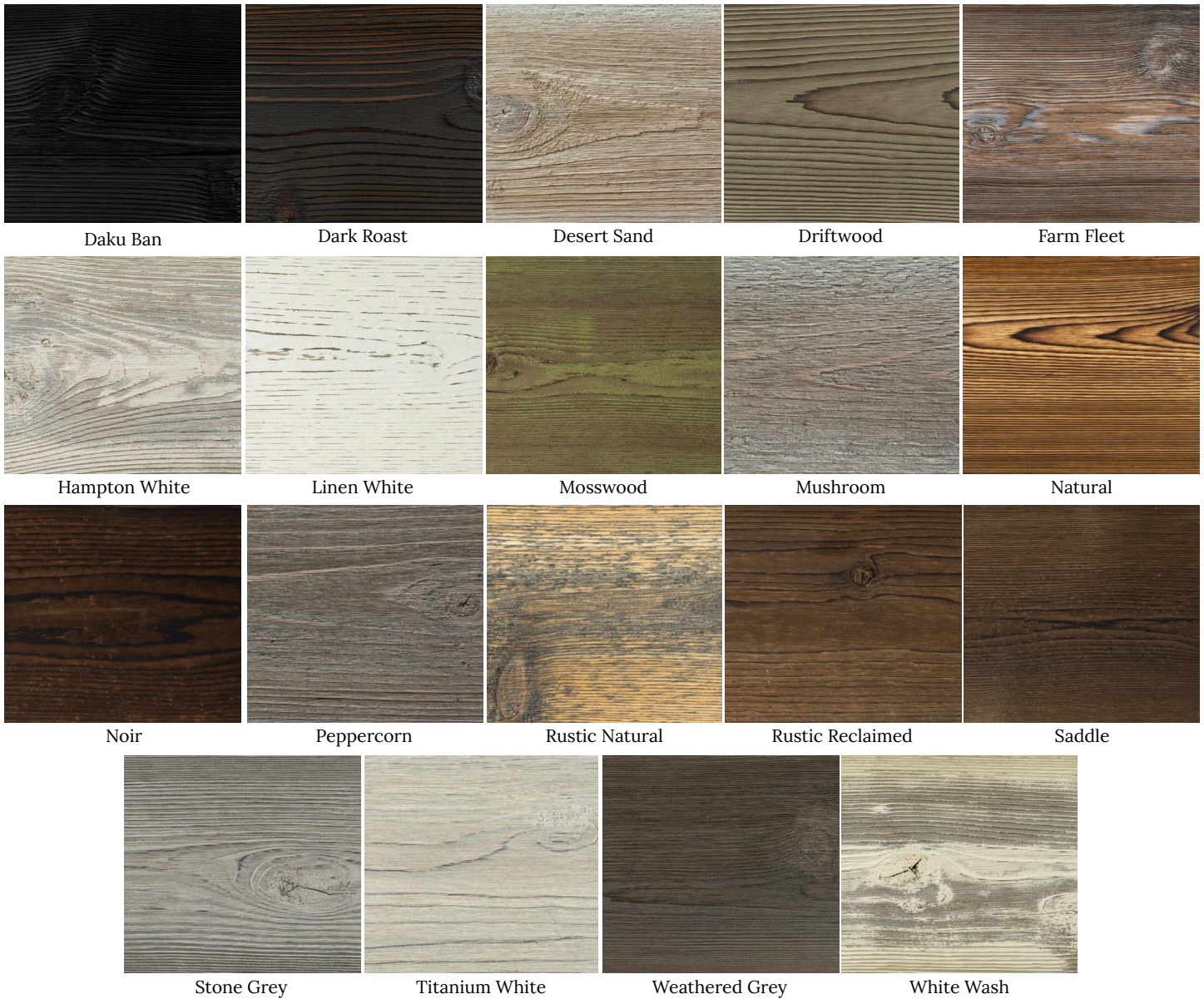

Lengths & Widths

One piece Cedar box beam lengths are available from 4' to 15'6". For lengths longer than 15'6", you can choose one of our joint options. All of our box beams are completely customizable to the specifications of your project. For Northwestern Spruce and Cedar, we offer standard widths from 3" to 10³/₄", and extended widths (requiring a glue-up) from 10⁷/₈" to 22". We also offer custom color matching and custom color formulations to ensure that our product is perfect for your installations.

End Caps

Our optional end caps are offered in two variants: Standard Grain and End Grain. Our Standard Grain features the same texture and finish found on the face of our beams. Our End Grain features a real wood cross-section, with visible tree rings.

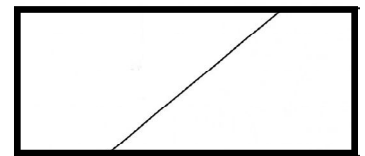
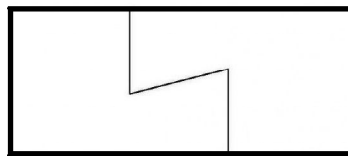
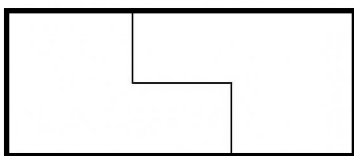

We also offer solid metal beam straps, in both a smooth and hammered texture, to accompany your chosen joint option. All straps are made-to-order to your specific dimensions, and are individually shaped for every beam.

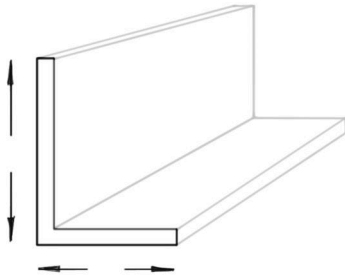

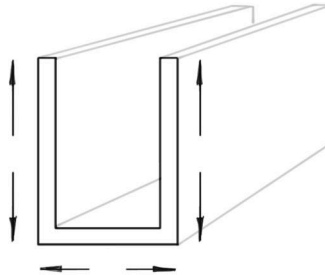

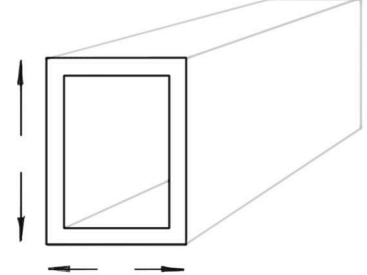
