In addition to our standard color and texture options, we also offer custom finishes, unfinished/raw box beams, and paint-grade options.

Lengths & Widths

One piece White Oak box beam lengths are available from 4' to 10'. For lengths longer than 10', you can choose one of our joint options. All of our box beams are completely customizable to the specifications of your project. For White Oak, we offer standard widths from 3" to 9", and extended widths (requiring a glue-up) from 9½" to 18". We also offer custom color matching and custom color formulations to ensure that our product is perfect for your installations.

End Caps

Our optional end caps are offered in two variants: Standard Grain and End Grain. Our Standard Grain features the same texture and finish found on the face of our beams. Our End Grain features a real wood cross-section, with visible tree rings.

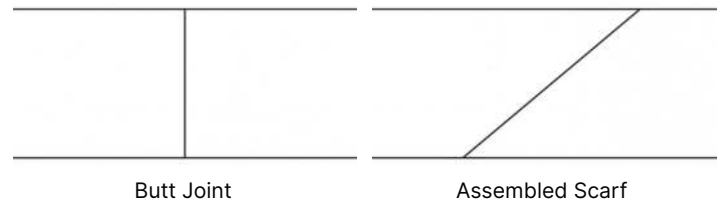

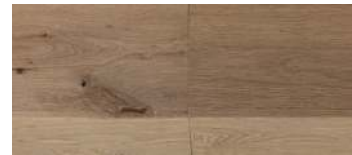

Butt Joint

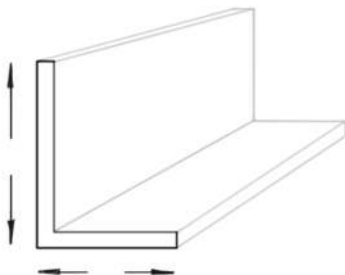

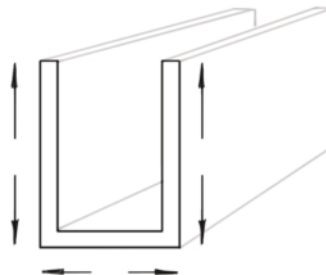

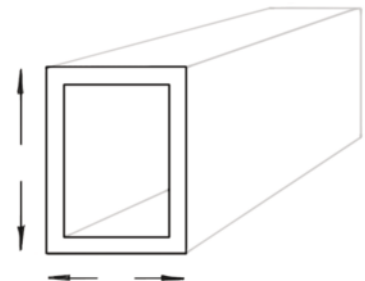
