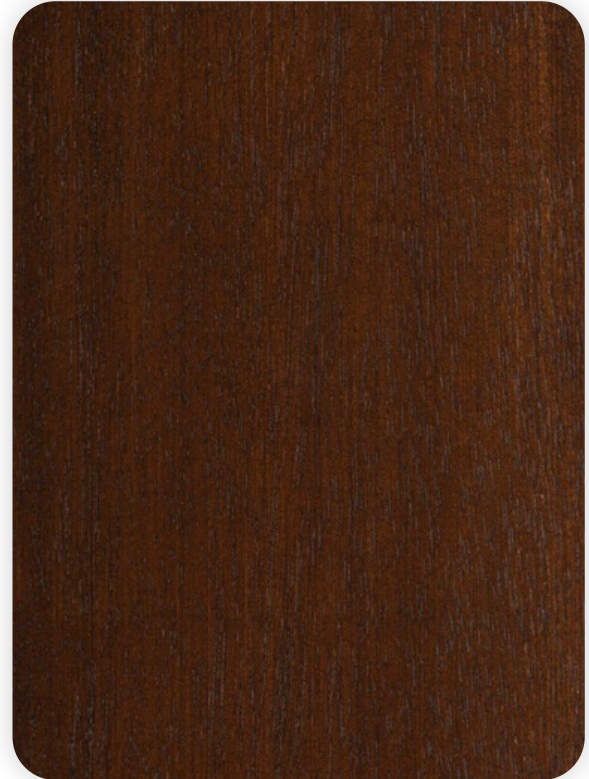


Mahogany

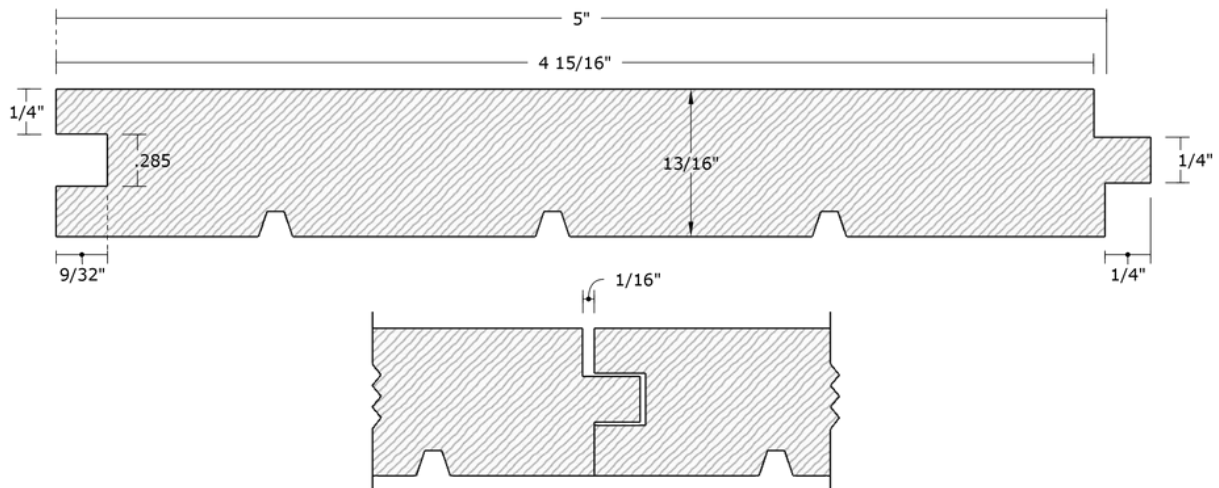
